POSITION SUMMARY:

The MetroWest YMCA is looking for a **part time Cafeteria Server** to join our team. In this role, you will be responsible for serving kids breakfast and lunch at our client site in Framingham.

We strive to produce healthy, from scratch meals for young children, school aged children, teenagers as well as the general public in our cafe. The job of cafeteria server ensures that all kids in program receive healthy, warm and safe meals during their school day. They will also prepare and package foods with accuracy, efficiency, and in a timely manner. Ensures that the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), Child and Adult Care Food Programs (CACFP), Changemaker Café, and catering operations have access to healthy food during program hours and support healthy eating practices across the MetroWest YMCA.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Manages and oversees the overall service of all meals to students at school
2. Prepare and package breakfast, lunch and snacks items in a timely manner
3. Transport food as needed

4. Ensure cleanliness of kitchen space including dish washing and daily maintenance
5. Peel, chop, slice, blend, and cook all fresh fruits, vegetables, and protein foods as directed and needed
6. Familiarize self with NSLP, SFSP, CACFP, and Healthy Eating & Physical Activity (HEPA) standards
7. Support meal distribution and enrichment activities at the YMCA, and other community organizations
8. Receive deliveries and restock items as needed
9. Maintain positive communications with all members and other YMCA staff members
10. Lead by example at all times. Interact with a high level of professionalism and accountability
11. Serve as a HEPA champion to implement across Association
12. Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be 18 years old or older
2. Prior Kitchen experience is required
3. Experience with commercial food handling and preparation is preferred
4. Completion or in process of attaining ServSafe and Allergen Awareness certification
5. The ability to develop positive, effective working relationships with, staff, children & families, volunteers, school administrators, members, community leaders and other agencies
6. Driver's license, satisfactory driving record and access to personal vehicle (preferred, not required) for transporting food to sites
7. Previous experience with diverse populations preferred
8. Must be able to reliably work Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 1:30pm
9. Bilingual in Spanish or Portuguese preferred
